Dear Ms. Olson,

The Contra Costa Water District provides the following brief recommendations regarding the December 18, 2007 Tentative Resolution Waiving Waste Discharge Requirements for the Contra Costa Water District and Victoria Island, LP Alternative Intake Project to Land San Joaquin and Contra Costa County.

- 1) Page 3 - Victoria Island Chloride lower end of the range should be 148 mg/L, not 138 mg/L.
- 2) Page 4- In the paragraph beginning with RESOLVED - project name needs to be corrected. It should be Alternative Intake Project, not Contra Costa Canal Replacement Phase 1.

CCWD agrees with the proposed waiver term of 31 December 2012. This will provide added flexibility in the event of construction delays.

CCWD will begin construction for the Alternative Intake Project starting as early as April 1, 2008. Your assistance to ensure that this matter is reviewed by the Central Valley Region of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board at the March 13/14 2008 meeting is appreciated.
