Dear Mr. Harvey:

Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on the tentative waster discharge requirements and master reclamation permit for the City of Clovis' (City) Sewage Treatment and Water Reuse Facility (ST/WRF).

As stated in the draft order, Discharge Point 001 is to the Fancher Creek Canal, which is maintained and operated by the Fresno Irrigation District (District). As you are well aware, any discharge to the Fancher Creek Canal will be subject to an agreement between the City of Clovis and the District. This agreement will need to be completed prior to any discharge from the City's ST/WRF to the Fancher Creek Canal and is in addition to the requirements of the Waste Discharge Permit that may be issued by the Regional Water Quality Control Board. This agreement will also require that the City be able dispose of its discharges other than in the Fancher Creek Canal (i.e. Discharge Point 002 – Diversion Channel to Little Dry Creek) when the District is not able to accept discharges into the Fancher Creek Canal.
