PUBLIC HEARING

Adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES No. CA0078956)
and Cease and Desist Order
for

CITY OF PLACERVILLE
HANGTOWN CREEK WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY
EL DORADO COUNTY

The City of Placerville (Discharger) owns and operates a municipal wastewater collection and treatment system consisting of primary, secondary, and tertiary treatment processes and disinfection. The Discharger is upgrading the treatment system to improve overall plant operation, provide effluent cooling, and convert the chlorination process to ultraviolet disinfection. Treated wastewater is discharged to Hangtown Creek, a tributary of the South Fork American River, via Weber Creek.

The Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will consider renewal of the Discharger's existing NPDES Permit, proposing: 1) new effluent limitations for Aluminum, Ammonia, Atrazine, Copper, Cyanide, Iron, Lead, Dibromochloromethane, Dichlorobromomethane, Manganese, Mercury, MTBE, Pesticides, Sulfide, and Electrical Conductivity; and 2) a new temperature receiving water limitation. A Cease and Desist Order is also proposed to include a compliance schedule for Turbidity, Total Coliform Organisms, and Nitrate-plus-Nitrite.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **4 April 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than by noon on **10 March 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon on **10 March 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross-examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
