TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a Notice of Public Hearing regarding tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES No. CA0082066) for Sierra Pacific Industries, Inc., Anderson Division. The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements were previously circulated for public comment on 24 May 2011. No comments were received by the comment deadline of 5:00 p.m. on 23 June 2011.

This item was previously scheduled to be considered at the Central Valley Water Board's April and August 2011 Board meetings, but was pulled from the Agenda due to the lack of a voting quorum.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 30 November, 1/2 December 2011 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a Proof of Posting form are enclosed. **By 27 October 2011** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by 4 November 2011. To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the Discharger only.
