



Continual Testing of Lime & Removal of Any Other Substances in Cac03 to Appropriate Off Site Waste Dumps

Work Only In Small Areas & Re-Cover Areas Each Night

Water Continually Areas Where Work Is Being Performed

Provide An On Site Sprinklers & Water Source To Keep Water Trucks & To Wash Off Trucks Hauling Lime Off Site

Cover & Tarp Loads

Do Not Work In Wind

Haul Any Loose Lime & Remove Immediately From Site
