TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES No. CA0082589) for the City of Redding, Stillwater Wastewater Treatment Plant. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 22 April 2013**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its **30, 31 May 2013 Board Meeting**. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 25 March 2013** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse;
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed); and
- The local newspaper (one (1) day publishing).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **2 April 2013**.
