The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 5/6 December 2013 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5 p.m. on 27 September 2013**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
