
I am writing on behalf of the Dellar Trust to separately respond to the City's August 2, 2010 status report.

As I noted in my letter of June 16, 2010, we are in agreement with the City that the matter needs to be worked out with the jurisdictional agencies. However, we have not been a party to those discussions. Of concern is the City's representation regarding the Trust's participation in a "full habitat conservation work plan." The Trust has not yet agreed with the City or the jurisdictional agencies as to the scope or extent of such a workplan. Instead, the Trust presently has the matter under advisement.

I would expect to have a clear statement of position on the matter later this month. I will at that time update the Board with a more definitive statement.
