Thanks for the call today. Below is our understanding of the agreement reached between Dellar and the City of Sacramento. As indicated, while the agreement appears acceptable with respect to CalRecycle's grant with the City of Sacramento, the necessary contracts need to be completed between Dellar and the City of Sacramento. In addition, we would expect to receive copies of the agreement.

Also as I mentioned, it is our intent to push these parties to get the site work completed this construction season. Just FYI, our grant is for \$720,500 and expires on May 15, 2014. It looks like the City can pay Dellar's contractors directly. I'm having the necessary contracts completed. The process would be:

CalRecycle reimburses City half of each invoice.
