TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR BURNEY FOREST PRODUCTS, A JOINT VENTURE, SHASTA GREEN, INC., AND FRUIT GROWERS SUPPLY COMPANY, BURNEY FOREST POWER COGENERATION PLANT AND SAWMILL, SHASTA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES No. CA0082490) for the Burney Forest Power Cogeneration Plant and Sawmill in Shasta County. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 10 February 2014**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its **27, 28 March 2014 Board Meeting**. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 13 January 2014** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse;
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **27 January 2014**.
