TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR CORRECTIVE ACTION AND CLOSURE
GLENN COUNTY CLASS III MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE LANDFILL
GLENN COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and a Monitoring and Reporting Program for Glenn County's Class III Municipal Solid Waste Landfill located approximately five miles west of the town of Artois, Glenn County. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 9 April 2014**. Written materials submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 9 April 2014** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 5/6 June 2014 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed.

By 10 March 2014 post one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **13 March 2014**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only. Interested persons are advised that the full text of the tentative documents is available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at:
