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**REVIEW OF WORK PLAN TO ADDRESS DRAINAGE CONCERNS, YUBA SUTTER  
DISPOSAL, INC., YUBA COUNTY**

Central Valley Water Board staff has reviewed the *Work Plan to Address Drainage Concerns* at the Yuba Sutter Disposal, Inc., which was submitted to address issues found during staff's 29 June 2011 inspection. The work plan was submitted on 15 September 2011.

According to the work plan, the Discharger has already corrected several areas that were noted as having deficient drainage. These areas include the entrance to the bin storage area/metal yard, and the entrance to the compost facility. Both areas reside on WMU LF-1. The work plan proposes to complete the drainage deficiencies and correct the ponding observed in the southeastern portion of WMU LF-1 by filling and regrading the area to drain. The Discharger is in the process of removing bins and the concrete rubble observed during the site inspection and the area has been resurveyed to establish drainage flow lines. The Discharger anticipates reestablishing drainage of the southeastern portion of WMU LF-1 by 31 October 2011.

Staff concurs with the drainage improvement plan. After drainage has been reestablished in the southeastern portion of WMU LF-1, the Discharger will submit a follow up report by **15 November 2011**.
