**Item 27.e      *Recology Hay Road, Recology Hay Road DBA Jepson Prairie Organics, Recology Hay Road Landfill, Solano County –Consideration of Revised Waste Discharge Requirements***

**Waste Discharge Requirements:**

Page 7, Finding 19	These WDRs allow the stockpiling of dewatered sludge on landfill modules that are Class II units and requires that all such operations be conducted consistent with the applicable O&M plans (e.g., Waste Materials Re-Use O&M Plan) required under Facility Specification C.2.
Page 65, Prohibition A.3	All discharges to LF-1 above shall be terminated by 15 October 2021. See Closure and Postclosure Specifications F.4.2.
Page 71, Specification B.9.b	The following wastes/materials are currently approved for use as ADC based on information in the JTD and demonstrations under previous WDRs: <b>b. C-Soil</b>
Page 74, Specification B.27.a	a. It is applied only between <b>15 April</b> <del>May</del> 15 <sup>th</sup> and <b>15 October</b> <del>15</del> 15 <sup>th</sup> each year.
Page 79 Specification D.4.c.i	Appropriate short term response measures may include, but not necessarily be limited to, those specified in MRP, section A.4.b (e.g., Central Valley Water Board notification, sampling, removal of fluid, monitoring of ongoing leak); feasible short-term measures under Corrective Action Specifications D.1 and D.4 if relevant (e.g., increase gas extraction rate, check liner edge for infiltration, enhance the runoff and drainage controls); and other appropriate short term measures.
