TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Strathmore Public Utility District, Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 23/24 June 2016 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 2 June 2016**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
