TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. 94-255; A. NONINI WINERY, INC., NONINI WINERY; FRESNO COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative order rescinding Waste Discharge Requirements Order 94-255 for the Nonini Winery (Facility) in Fresno County. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering the adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 18/19 April 2024 meeting. Any comments or recommendations you or others may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted in writing to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 16 February 2024**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

In order to conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the tentative Rescission Order has been sent only to the Discharger.
