REVISED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board) has released proposed waste discharge requirements and a monitoring and reporting program for discharges from irrigated lands within the eastern San Joaquin River watershed. The proposed waste discharge requirements and monitoring and reporting program rely on the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program, Program Environmental Impact Report (Resolution R5-2011-0017) for California Environmental Quality Act compliance.

The public hearing concerning this matter has been re-scheduled. The hearing will not be held at the Central Valley Water Board's October meeting as originally scheduled. The hearing will be held during the Central Valley Water Board's December meeting, which is scheduled at the time and location noted below:

Interested persons will be provided the opportunity to present oral comments to the Central Valley Water Board at the hearing. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Central Valley Water Board Chair. Interested persons may be asked to respond to clarifying questions from Central Valley Water Board members, counsel, staff, or others, at the discretion of the Central Valley Water Board Chair. The Chair may, at his discretion, allow presenters to supplement their oral testimony with slides or other digital media. If you plan to use visual aids such as PowerPoint slides, contact staff prior to the meeting to arrange for equipment set-up. You must provide a printed or electronic copy of any visual aids.

Written comments on this item **were due on 6 August 2012**. Additional written comments will **not** be received on this item. Materials received by 6 August have been included in the administrative record and a response to those comments will be prepared. Written comments shall not be read into the record unless allowed by the Water Board Chair.
