Additionally, management plans and draft templates for farm evaluation, nitrogen management, and sediment and erosion control plans will be available for public comment before the Executive Officer's decision.

- ⁽¹⁾ The EO issued a Notice of Applicability (NOA) approving the third-party's request to represent growers on 11 January 2013.
- ⁽²⁾ Deadline if the third-party elects to prepare farm templates with other water quality coalitions and agricultural commodity groups, an alternative option is available to work with the Central Valley Water Board staff to develop templates.
- ⁽³⁾ Vulnerability designations must be reviewed every 5 years (2019, 2024, 2029) – the assessment can be included in the Monitoring Report.
- ⁽⁴⁾ In addition to Monitoring Well Installation and Sampling Plan, Monitoring Well Installation Completion Reports are due 60 days after completion of any monitoring network, or monitoring well construction data are due 90 days after well completion. Summary MPEP reports are due 6 years after each stage is completed.
