

## **CIWQS Public Reports Workshop**

This is the second public workshop on developing reports from CIWQS specifically for public use. We are interested in public input on how to make CIWQS useful to the general public, environmental groups, and the discharger community. This is your opportunity to contribute to the future direction taken with new reports and in shaping how we will work with stakeholders to meet their needs.

During this workshop, Darrin Polhemus and Nancy Miller, and their staff from the Divisions of Water Quality and Information Technology, will:

- Review the functionality and content of reports currently available,
- Preview plans for new reports,
- Ask for comments and suggestions on the existing and future reports, and
- Solicit feedback on the public input process.

The workshop will be on February 8, 2007 from 2:00 to 4:00, in the Sierra Hearing Room at the Cal/EPA Building. There will also be an audio webcast and a limited number of connections available via WebEx.
