**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR
MATICH CORPORATION
Banning - Riverside County**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. Match Corporation (hereinafter also referred to as the discharger), P. O. Box 50,000, San Bernardino, California, 92412, submitted a report of waste discharge dated January 10, 1984, for a proposed discharge and, also, information dated February 16, 1984, to update waste discharge requirements for the existing discharge.
2. The discharger is currently discharging an average daily flow of 16,000 gpd of wastewater from gravel crushing and asphalt mixing plants located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T3S, R1E, SBB&M. The discharger proposes an additional discharge of 2,000 gallons per day of wastewater plus solids consisting of surplus concrete and mixer washout water.
3. Wastewater is discharged into unlined basins with final disposal by evaporation and infiltration. The proposed mixer washout discharge will occur in basins constructed in gravel pits where excavation has been terminated.
4. The beneficial uses of ground waters in the San Gorgonio Subarea of the Whitewater Hydrologic unit are:
 - a. Municipal supply
 - b. Agricultural supply
 - c. Industrial supply
5. The Water Quality Control Plan for the Colorado River Basin Region of California was adopted by the Regional Board on May 16, 1984. The Basin Plan contains water quality objectives for the Whitewater hydrologic unit and this Order implements those objectives.
6. The discharger has been subject to waste discharge requirements contained in this Board's Order No. 71-48.
7. The Board has notified the discharger and interested persons and agencies of its intent to update waste discharge requirements for this discharge.
8. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharge.

WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region,
finds that:

1. Match Corporation (hereinafter also referred to as the discharger), P. O. Box 50,008, San Bernardino, California, 92413, submitted a report of waste discharge dated January 18, 1984, for a proposed discharge and, also, information dated February 18, 1984, to update waste discharge requirements for the existing discharge.

2. The discharger is currently discharging an average daily flow of 18,000 gpd of wastewater from gravel crushing and asphalt mixing plants located in the 521 1/2 Section 3, T2S, R1E, S882M. The discharger proposes an additional discharge of 2,000 gallons per day of wastewater plus solids consisting of surplus concrete and mixer washout water.

3. Wastewater is discharged into unlined basins with final disposal by evaporation and infiltration. The proposed mixer washout discharge will occur in basins constructed in gravel pits where excavation has been terminated.

4. The beneficial uses of ground waters in the San Geronimo Subarea of the
wastewater hydrologic unit are:

- a. municipal supply
- b. agricultural supply
- c. industrial supply

5. The water quality control plan for the Colorado River Basin Region of California was adopted by the Regional Board on May 18, 1984. The Basin Plan contains water quality objectives for the Whitewater hydrologic unit and this Order implements those objectives.

6. The discharger has been subject to waste discharge requirements contained in this Board's Order No. VI-48.

7. The Board has notified the discharger and interested persons and agencies of its intent to update waste discharge requirements for this discharge.

8. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharge.

9. This wastewater disposal operation constitutes an ongoing project in accordance with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et. seq.) and State guidelines because the governmental approvals on or after April 5, 1973, do not involve a greater degree of responsibility or control over such activity than the governmental approvals received prior to that date.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the discharger shall comply with the following:

A. Discharge Specifications

1. The treatment or disposal of wastes shall not cause pollution or a nuisance as defined in Section 13050 (l) and 13050 (m) of the California Water Code.
2. Discharged wastewaters shall not contain constituents in excess of the following limits:

<u>Constituents</u>	<u>Units</u>	<u>Maximum</u>
Total Dissolved Solids	mg/l	300


3. Wastewater with chemical constituents in excess of the limits prescribed in Discharge Specification No. A. 2 (above) shall be retained in impervious basins with ultimate discharge at a location approved by the Regional Board.
4. There shall be no surface flow of wastewater away from the designated disposal area.
5. Adequate protective works shall be provided to assure that flood or surface drainage waters do not erode or otherwise render portions of the disposal facilities inoperable.

B. Provisions

1. Prior to any material change in the quality or quantity of wastewater discharged, or any material change in the location of discharge, the discharger shall report thereon to the Board.
2. In the event of any change in operation, or in control or ownership of the land used for wastewater disposal, the discharger shall:
 - a. Notify this Board of such change; and
 - b. Transmit a copy of this Order to the succeeding owner or operator, and file a copy of the transmittal with this Board.

3. The discharger shall comply with "Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 84-84", and future revisions thereto, as specified by the Executive Officer.
4. This Order supersedes Board Order No. 71-48.




