YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

As of December 11, 1992, you are in violation of the following:


1. Progress Report required by Order No. 92-048 by October 1, 1992 has not been received.
2. Technical Report required by Order No. 92-048 by December 1, 1992, has not been received.

As of December 11, 1992, the above violations have not been satisfactorily corrected. This Notice of Violation serves as a final notice to correct the above actions by January 1, 1993. If you fail to correct the above violations by this date, the Board may take appropriate enforcement actions authorized by the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, Division 7 of the California Water Code, commencing with Section 13000, including the possible assessment of civil liabilities of \$5,000.00 per day of violation, or referral to the State Attorney General for judicial sanctions.

This notice is based on the following specific circumstances:

1. A progress report which details the progress being made toward goals outlined in the workplan, was not received by this office.
2. A technical report which fully delineates the extent of contamination of soil and ground water, characterizes the site hydrology and evaluated the actual and potential off-site migration of the contaminants, was not received by this office.
