ORDER NO. R7-2012-0039

**RESCISSION OF
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT
AND
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. For the reasons stated below, it is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Order.
2. The Board timely forwarded notices by mail to persons responsible for the below-listed Board Order explaining the Board's consideration of rescinding the particular Board Order, and requesting comments.
3. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Board Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the following Board Order, containing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements, be rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.



The discharger failed to comply with the condition of the permit to submit its renewal application 180 days prior to the expiration date of June 26, 2012. The facility has not been operational for the past five years and is not discharging effluent into the receiving water. The discharger has been contacted and is aware that a new application will be required at least 180 days prior to discharge and a new NPDES permit will be issued. Therefore, the existing Board Order is no longer required.

R7-2007-0037	PARKER DAM AND POWER PLANT DRINKING WATER FACILITY	June 26, 2007

The Board Order is being rescinded because the facility is no longer discharging to the Colorado River and has been discharging to land for disposal. The discharger has requested the termination of the NPDES permit. Therefore, the existing Board Order is no longer required.
