**CHANGE OF NAME AND/OR OWNERSHIP OF FACILITIES  
HAVING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Colorado River Basin Water Board), finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Order is for a facility that has had a change of name and/or ownership since adoption of the Board Order.
2. The below-listed Board Order should be revised to show the current name and/or ownership of this facility.
3. The Colorado River Basin Water Board has notified each discharger of its intent to amend the below-listed Board Order by substituting therein the current name and/or ownership of the facilities.
4. The Colorado River Basin Water Board heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed change of name and/or ownership of each facility for the below-listed Board Order.
5. This action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) in accordance with the categorical exemption set forth in Section 15301, Title 14, California Code of Regulations, which governs the operation of an existing facility involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing.
