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The Executive Officer (EO) of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Regional Water Board) hereby provides the following report on recent staff activities in the region:

LAND DISPOSAL - WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS PROGRAM

Notices of Noncompliance: 385 Notices of Noncompliance were issued to homeowners/residents in the Town of Yucca Valley, subject to the Yucca Valley Basin Plan Prohibition.

UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) AND SITE CLEANUP PROGRAM (SCP)
