GENERAL INFORMATION PERTAINING TO WATER RIGHTS IN CALIFORNIA
There are two principal types of surface water rights in California. They are riparian and appropriative rights.

A riparian right enables an owner of land bordering a natural lake or stream to take and use water on his riparian land. Riparian land must be in the same watershed as the water source and must never have been severed from the sources of supply by an intervening parcel without reservation of the riparian right to the severed parcel. Generally, a riparian water user must share the water supply with other riparian users. Riparian rights may be used to divert the natural flow of a stream but may not be used to store water for later use or to divert water which originates in a different watershed, water previously stored by others, return flows from use of groundwater, or other "foreign" water to the natural stream system.

An appropriative right is required for use of water on non-riparian land and for storage of water. Generally, appropriative rights may be exercised only when there is a surplus not needed by riparian water users. After the formation of the California Water Commission back on December 19, 1914, new appropriators have been required to obtain a permit and license from the State. Appropriative rights can be granted to waters "foreign" to the natural stream system.

Statements of Water Diversion and Use must be filed by riparian and pre-1914 appropriative water users as set forth in Water Code section 5100 with specific exceptions. The filing of a statement (1) provides a record of water use, (2) enables the State to notify such users if someone proposes a new appropriation upstream from their diversions, and (3) assists the State to determine if additional water is available for future appropriators.

Enclosed are two Statements of Water Diversion and Use that are submitted on behalf of the Plumas Pines Golf Resort ("Plumas Pines"), in accordance with Water Code section 5100, et seq.

Plumas Pines uses water from several sources for irrigation of approximately 80 acres of land at the golf resort. The sources include stream flow diverted from Jamison Creek under claim of pre-1914 water right; diversion of water from the Middle Fork of the Feather River under claim of riparian water right; and the pumping of percolating groundwater from a well located on the golf course, which is part of the 80 acres of land at the golf resort.

Jamison Creek. Jamison Creek is the primary source of water used by Plumas Pines. Water diverted from Jamison Creek is transported to the golf course via Lundy Ditch, a 3-1/2 mile long earthen ditch. In 2002, this ditch failed and Plumas Pines was unable to divert water from Jamison Creek. Plumas Pines (and other agencies) are currently developing plans for the construction of a pipeline in Lundy Ditch that would allow Plumas Pines to resume diversion of water from Jamison Creek in calendar year 2005. During the interim period, Plumas Pines relies on groundwater and diversion of water from the Middle Fork of the Feather River to meet the irrigation needs on the golf course.

Enclosed is a Statement of Water Diversion and Use for calendar years 2000, 2001, and 2002 for this diversion. A Location Map is attached to that Statement that shows the location of the diversion on Jamison Creek, Lundy ditch and the golf course.

My letters to the Division of Water Rights dated July 20, 2003 and October 2, 2003, provide detailed information to document the basis and extent of Plumas Pines claim of pre-1914 water for this diversion.

Groundwater. In the mid 1900s, Plumas Pines drilled a 120 foot deep well on the golf course to provide a back-up supply of water. Since the failure of Lundy Ditch in 2002, Plumas Pines has relied primarily on the use of percolating groundwater to meet the irrigation demand on the golf course, the resort, and emergency fire flow requirements.

Middle Fork Feather River. During August and September of 2002, the pump in the well could not pump sufficient water to meet the irrigation demand on the golf course. As a result, Plumas Pines was forced to directly divert water from the Middle Fork of the Feather under claim of riparian right to supplement the water pumped from the well in order to prevent the grass from dying on the fairways, greens, and landscaped area. Plumas Pines diverted approximately 4 acre-feet of water in August and September in 2002.

Enclosed is a Statement of Water Diversion and Use for calendar year 2002 for this diversion. A Location Map reprinted from a USGS topographic map is attached to that statement to show the location of the Feather River diversion. 

GENERAL INFORMATION PERTAINING TO WATER RIGHTS IN CALIFORNIA

There are two principal types of surface water rights in California. They are riparian and appropriative rights.

A riparian right enables an owner of land bordering a natural lake or stream to take and use water on his riparian land. Riparian land must be in the same watershed as the water source and must never have been severed from the sources of supply by an intervening parcel without reservation of the riparian right to the severed parcel. Generally, a riparian water user must share the water supply with other riparian users. Riparian rights may be used to divert the natural flow of a stream but may not be used to store water for later use or divert water which originates in a different watershed, or return flows from use of groundwater.

An appropriative right is required for use of water on nonriparian land and for storage of water. Generally, appropriative rights may be exercised only when there is a surplus not needed by riparian water users. Since 1914 new appropriators have been required to obtain a permit and license from the State.

Statements of Water Diversion and Use must be filed by a riparian and per-1914 appropriative water users. The filling of a statement (1) provides a record of water use, (2) enables the State to notify such users if someone proposes a new appropriation upstream from their diversion, and (3) assists the State to determine if additional water is available for future appropriators.






LOCATION MAP
