**Subject:** Arimol-Surface Water Delineation

Bill, Bruce, and Dale,

Thank you for submitting the *Final Surface Water Delineation Work Plan, Arimol Group, Inc. and Meadowbrook Cedar, Inc. Properties, Lake Arrowhead, San Bernardino County, August 29, 2013 (Work Plan)*. The Water Board's Prosecution Team received the Work Plan via electronic mail on August 30, 2013. The Prosecution Team has completed its review and accepts the Work Plan with no further comments or conditions.

The Prosecution Team also appreciates your close coordination during the development of the Work Plan. Such coordination led to you addressing the Prosecution Team's remaining issues prior to submitting the Work Plan, which allowed you to begin implementing the field work portion of the Work Plan on August 26, 2013. I understand that the field work portion of the Work Plan has been completed and the Prosecution Team is looking forward to receiving the results and the proposed restoration plan.

You have now satisfied the first two requirements of the proposed Cleanup and Abatement Order. The Prosecution Team appreciates your willingness to continue taking the necessary steps towards restoring the surface waters at the Meadowbrook site, according to the schedule in the proposed Cleanup and Abatement Order. The Water Board's Executive Officer, Patty Kouyoumdjian, has returned as of this week. I anticipate that the Water Board's Advisory Team will complete its review of the proposed Cleanup and Abatement Order shortly, and based upon the Advisory Team's July 26, 2013 electronic mail, we should expect the Cleanup and Abatement Order to be issued shortly thereafter.
