
Dear Mr. Feng:

We have revised the tentative TSO, dated May 18, 2011, for the Camarillo Water Reclamation Plant (Camarillo WRP) based on comments received by the June 17, 2011, 12:00 p.m. (Noon) deadline. Written responses to comments received and the revised tentative TSO are enclosed. Changes in the revised tentative TSO appear in ~~strikeout~~ and underline format.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on July 14, 2011, at 9:00 a.m., at the City of Simi Valley, Council Chambers, 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California, will consider the enclosed revised tentative TSO and written comments regarding the tentative TSO. **Please note that the location of the Board meeting has changed.** The Board will also hear any oral testimony and comments pertinent to the tentative TSO. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.
