TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT / TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER – CHEVRON PRODUCTS COMPANY, EL SEGUNDO REFINERY, EL SEGUNDO, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA 0000337, CI NO. 1603)

Dear Ms. Worley:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) has completed a review of your application for the renewal of your permit to discharge waste under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program. Pursuant to the federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and in accordance with the State Water Code, tentative waste discharge requirements have been prepared. In addition, in response to your request we have also prepared the tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) relative to this discharge that will be considered at the same hearing with the tentative permit.

Enclosed are copies of the following:

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Board at a public hearing to be held on **October 5, 2017** at 9:00 a.m., at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California; will consider the enclosed tentative requirements, tentative TSO and comments submitted in writing regarding any and all portions thereof. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge, the tentative requirements and the tentative TSO. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing, however, as testimony dictates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.

Written comments pertaining to this proposed Board action must be emailed to losangeles@waterboards.ca.gov with a copy to thomas.siebels@waterboards.ca.gov, no later than close of business on **September 18, 2017**. Please reference the comments as "Comments on tentative NPDES Permit, Chevron Products Company, CA0000337". Comments or evidence received after that date will be submitted, ex agenda, to the Board for consideration, but only included in the administrative record with express approval of the Chair during the hearing. Additionally, if the Board receives only supportive comments, the permit may be placed on the Board's consent calendar, and approved without an oral testimony.

With respect to the public notice, in accordance with the federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and the California Code of Regulations, you are required to follow the enclosed instructions for publication or posting of the notice no later than **August 23, 2017**.

Failure to publish or post the notice by the above date will force us to reschedule this item for a later hearing and will require the publication or posting of a second notice. Please notify Regional Board staff by telephone when the notice has been published and submit the proof of publication or posting as required by the enclosed instructions. Proof of posting or publication of the notice must be received by the Executive Officer of this Regional Board no later than **September 1, 2017**.
