TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – Joint Outfall System, Joint Water Pollution Control Plant (NPDES Permit No. CA0053813, CI-1758)

We have completed our review of your application for renewal of the permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program.

Pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and in accordance with the California Water Code, tentative waste discharge requirements have been prepared.

It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.


