REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs)/ NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND REVISED TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) – CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS, HILL CANYON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0056294, CI-4917)

On March 13, 2014, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff sent you a tentative TSO, WDRs and NPDES permit for the above-mentioned Water Reclamation Plant. Regional Water Board staff considered comments submitted by the April 14, 2014, public comment deadline and prepared the enclosed written response to comments table and revised tentative orders.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on **May 8, 2014, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the **City of Simi Valley Council Chambers, 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California**, will consider the enclosed Tentative Requirements and comments submitted in writing regarding the changes contained within the proposed revised tentative Orders. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the revised tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
