**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF  
AMENDED TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) FOR  
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
(National Pollutant Discharges Elimination System (NPDES) Permit)**

Camarillo Sanitary District (hereinafter the Camarillo SD) discharges tertiary-treated wastewater, from its Camarillo Water Reclamation Plant (Camarillo WRP) into Conejo Creek, tributary to Calleguas Creek, waters of the United States. The discharge is regulated under waste discharge requirements contained in Order No. R4-2014-0062, adopted by this Regional Board on May 8, 2014. Order No. R4-2014-0062 serves as a permit under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES No. CA0053597). On May 8, 2014, the Regional Water Board also amended Time Schedule Order (TSO) No. R4-2011-0126-A02, which prescribed Camarillo SD interim effluent limits for chloride, sulfate, and total dissolved solids (TDS).

Camarillo SD has been making progress towards complying with the terms of the TSO by completing several sections of the capital improvement project and by submitting timely progress reports regarding the status of the project. Camarillo SD notified the Regional Water Board that they encountered difficulties in obtaining the necessary easements to be able to construct two segments of the salinity management pipeline. On September 18, 2015, Camarillo SD requested a 12-month extension of the TSO deadlines due to these delays; and subsequently submitted documentation demonstrating that additional time is needed for Camarillo SD to continue negotiations with property owners and, if necessary, to proceed with an eminent domain proceeding.

On the basis of preliminary staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, the Executive Officer, pursuant to his delegated authority from the Regional Water Board, tentatively proposes to amend TSO No. R4-2011-0126-A02, by extending certain interim milestone deadlines by one year. The Executive Officer is not proposing changes to the final compliance deadline of December 31, 2017. In addition, no changes to the NPDES permit are being proposed at this time.

Please be advised that the Executive Officer intends to issue the Amended TSO without a public hearing. Because interested persons may not have an opportunity to make oral comments, interested persons must submit all comments in writing as described below. The Executive Officer will consider all timely written comments prior to administratively issuing the Amended TSO.

WRITTEN COMMENTS AND SUBMITTAL OF EVIDENCE

Persons wishing to comment on and/or submit evidence regarding the Tentative Amended TSO for the Executive Officer to consider must submit written comments. Written comments must be **received** by the Regional Water Board by 5:00 p.m. on December 3, 2015. Failure to submit timely written comments is also grounds for the Regional Water Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comment or exhibit into evidence pursuant to section 648.4, title 23 of the California Code of Regulations.
