TENTATIVE AMENDED CEASE AND DESIST ORDER FOR FORESTER AND FIRE WARDEN CAMP 13 WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, 1250 SOUTH ENCINAL CANYON ROAD, MALIBU, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 61-108, ORDER NOS. R4-2015-0121 AND R4-2015-0122, CI-3138, GLOBAL ID WDR100001050)

Dear Mr. Tizani,

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board), is the state agency with primary responsibility for the protection of ground and surface water quality for all beneficial uses within major portions of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, including the referenced property above.

Regional Board staff have completed the review of a time extension request for Cease and Desist Order (CDO) No. R4-2015-0122 for Forester and Fire Warden Camp 13 wastewater treatment plant. Pursuant to the California Water Code, a tentative amended CDO has been prepared. Enclosed is a copy of the tentative amended CDO.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Board will consider the enclosed tentative amended CDO and comments timely received, at a public hearing to be held at 9:00 AM on July 14, 2016, at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California. The Regional Board will hear any testimony pertinent to the tentative amended CDO. It is expected that the Regional Board will take action to adopt, modify, or reject the tentative amended CDO at the hearing. However, please note that the Regional Board at its discretion may postpone action on the proposed CDO to a subsequent board meeting.

In order to be fully evaluated by Regional Board staff and included in the Regional Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received at the Regional Board office by 5:00 p.m. on **June 27, 2016**. Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Regional Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comment or exhibit into evidence. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Regional Board staff is able to provide a timely review, and that Regional Board Members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.
