**NOTICE OF CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)  
SCOPING MEETING**

In the Matter of Proposed Amendments  
To the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region  
To Establish Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for Bacteria at Marina del Rey,  
Mothers' Beach and Back Basins and TMDLs for Toxics at Marina del Rey Back Basins

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) will hold a CEQA scoping meeting pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 21083.9 to receive comments on the appropriate scope and content of the "functionally equivalent" environmental document to be prepared pursuant to Section 2080.5 of the California Environmental Quality Act. The proposed amendments would involve:

- Incorporation of a TMDL for bacteria, a TMDL for toxics, and TMDL implementation programs for bacteria and for toxics at Marina del Rey Mothers' Beach and Back Basins.
