

The City of Culver City (City) supports the approval of the Time Schedule Order (TSO) for Ballona Creek, Ballona Estuary, and Sepulveda Channel Dry Weather Bacteria Total Maximum Daily Load (Bacteria TMDL). The City has implemented numerous actions in the Ballona Creek Watershed since the Bacteria TMDL became effective on April 27, 2007 as mentioned in the tentative TSO dated March 27, 2015.
