CONFIRMATION OF INCORPORATION OF OUTSTANDING CONDITIONS INTO THE MARINA DEL REY COORDINATED INTEGRATED MONITORING PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) PERMIT (NPDES PERMIT NO. CAS004001; ORDER NO. R4-2012-0175 AS AMENDED BY STATE WATER BOARD ORDER WQ 2015-0075 AND LOS ANGELES WATER BOARD ORDER R4-2012-0175-A01)

Dear Permittees of the Marina del Rey Watershed Management Group<sup>1</sup>:

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board or Board) has reviewed the Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (CIMP) submitted on October 4, 2018, by the Marina del Rey Watershed Management Group (MdR Group). The revised CIMP was submitted to fulfill the additional requirements listed in the Los Angeles Water Board's August 30, 2018, conditional approval letter.

After a review of the MdR Group's CIMP dated October 4, 2018, it was determined that the CIMP includes the additional sampling required in conditions 1 and 3 of the August 30, 2018 approval letter. Condition 2 required the Permittees to conduct a TSS time series study and condition 4 included directives for conducting and reporting load calculations for the front and back basins. On January 31, 2019, the County of Los Angeles reported that the TSS time series report will be

submitted in July 2019 and load calculations will continue to be reported in the annual report due yearly in December. The MdR CIMP dated October 4, 2018 hereby constitutes the final approved CIMP for the Permittees in the Marina del Rey Watershed Management Group.
