RECISSION OF
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER NO. R1-2000-94

CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
REDWOOD CREEK BRIDGE MAINTENANCE

Humboldt County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (hereinafter Regional Water Board), finds that:

1. On November 29, 2000, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2000-94 for California Department of Transportation (CDOT), Redwood Creek Bridge Maintenance.
2. The Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2000-94 were adopted for the maintenance, washing, and repainting of the Redwood Creek Bridge on State Route 299 at postmile R22.33 east of Lord Ellis Summit.
3. CDOT is conducting a structural assessment of the bridge due to the presence of stress cracks. The repainting project has been postponed until 2007 or later, depending on the findings of the evaluation. Order No. R1-2000-94 is not needed until the project is resumed or redefined in the future.
4. The action to rescind waste discharge requirements is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), at Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq., pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15061(b)(3).
5. The Regional Water Board has notified CDOT and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind Order No. R1-2000-94 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
6. The Regional Water Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order No. R1-2000-94 for California Department of Transportation, Redwood Creek Bridge Maintenance is rescinded.
