Mendocino County

The North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board, (hereinafter Regional Water Board) finds that:

1. On August 26, 1998, the Regional Water Board received a Report of Waste Discharge from the County of Mendocino, Department of Transportation (hereinafter discharger), for the replacement of the East Side Potter Valley Road bridge over the East Fork of the Russian River (Bridge No. 10C-102), located in Mendocino County.
2. The project consisted of the replacement of the old East Side Potter Valley Road Bridge. The old bridge consisted of a four-span concrete T-beam with masonry abutments constructed in 1953. The bridge was approximately 42 feet wide by 142 feet long and the design speed was 25 miles per hour. The bridge did not meet current design and safety standards. The replacement bridge is a three-span post tensioned reinforced concrete box-girder, approximately 43 feet wide with a six-foot wide sidewalk on either side, 463 feet long. Construction has been completed on the replacement bridge. Therefore, the discharger no longer needs Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs).

3. The action to rescind WDRs is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq., pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Sections 15060(c)(2) and 15061(b)(3).
4. The Regional Water Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind Order No. 98-85 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
5. The Regional Water Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order No. 98-85, WDRs and Monitoring and Reporting Program for the County of Mendocino Department of Transportation for the replacement of the East Side Potter Valley Road Bridge is rescinded.
