Recision of Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 91-66 and
Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 91-66

The Executive Officer of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (hereinafter the Regional Water Board) finds that:

1. On May 23, 1991, the Regional Water Board issued Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 91-66 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 91-66 to monitor discharges from a vehicle wash rack at CDOT Bodega Bay Maintenance Station, 2030 Highway One, Bodega Bay, CA.
2. Use of the vehicle wash rack was discontinued in 1995.
3. The wash rack has been decommissioned.
4. Waste Discharge Requirements are no longer necessary.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 91-66 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 91-66 be rescinded.
