RECISSION OF MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM NO. R1-2000-20

Humboldt County

1. On March 24, 2000, Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2000-20 was issued for the Marsh Commons facility located at 101 South G Street in Arcata. The Order contained directions for monitoring and reporting data collected from the monitoring wells installed at the facility.
2. On October 19, 2001 all cleanup and abatement activities associated with this site were considered complete. No further monitoring of the groundwater is necessary.
3. Because all cleanup and abatement activities associated with this site are considered complete and monitoring of the groundwater at the site is no longer necessary, Monitoring and Reporting Program R1-2000-20 is hereby rescinded.
