MONITORING

The presence of floating product shall be evaluated in each monitoring well quarterly. If detected, the thickness shall be measured to at least 0.01 foot increments.

The depth to groundwater in each monitoring well shall be determined to at least 0.01 foot increments quarterly. The results of each event's elevation shall be reported in tabular form indicating the surveyed elevations of each well reference point, depth to groundwater from reference point, and the actual groundwater elevation. The data generated from the elevation readings must be referenced to mean sea level.

Each monitoring well shall be sampled quarterly according to the following schedule. The analyses shall be performed at a certified laboratory for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) as gasoline, TPH as diesel, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes.

Each monitoring well shall be sampled in accordance with Attachment A of General Waste Discharge Requirements R1-2004-0020.

REPORTING

A groundwater elevation contour map shall be submitted for each set of measurements and include the facility, groundwater flow pattern including the direction of the groundwater gradient, and the location of the wells measured.

Sampling analytical and monitoring data shall be summarized in tabular form, including all previously generated sampling data.

All analytical results and depth to groundwater measurements must be submitted electronically to the State Water Resources Control Board's Geographic Environmental Information Management System database (GeoTracker).

Monitoring reports, including gradient data and sampling data, shall be submitted to the Regional Water Board quarterly, in accordance with the following schedule:
