1. On January 5, 2004, Catherine E. Kuhlman, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) issued Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2004-003 for the Cash Oil Company facility located at 409 South Fortuna Boulevard in Fortuna (Site). The Order contained requirements for monitoring and reporting data collected from monitoring wells installed at the Site. The monitoring was required to comply with General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2000-51 issued to Cash Oil Company on January 5, 2004.
2. On October 28, 2004 Catherine E. Kuhlman, Executive Officer of Regional Water Board concurred with the request to terminate coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements No. R1-2000-51. Based on the available information, it is appropriate to rescind Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2004-003.
