RESCISION OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER NO. R1-2004-0115

For

LOLETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY

Humboldt County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (hereinafter Regional Water Board) finds that:

1. The Loleta Community Services District (hereinafter Permittee) owns and operates a municipal wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) located in Loleta, California. Treated WWTF effluent discharges to an evaporation/ percolation pond, which during winter months, overflows to an unnamed slough, tributary to the Eel River.
2. The Executive Officer of the Regional Water Board issued Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R1-2004-0115 to the Permittee on December 2, 2004.
3. Between December 2004 and March 2005, and in compliance with the time schedule set forth under Order No. R1-2004-0115, the Permittee submitted signed contracts for properly licensed operators to run the WWTF, weekly progress reports, a long-term plan for properly certified operations of the WWTF, and supplemental explanations as requested by Regional Water Board staff.
4. Documentation submitted by the Permittee confirms that actions necessary to obtain and reasonably assure continued licensed operation of the WWTF have been met.
5. Regional Water Board action to rescind Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R1-2004-0115 is exempt from provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15061(b)(3).

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R1-2004-0115 is rescinded.
