1. On May 17, 2004, Catherine E. Kuhlman, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2004-0044 for the Pacific Lumber Company facility located at 121 Main Street in Scotia (Site). The Order contained requirements for monitoring and reporting data collected to assess the effects of the injection of hydrogen peroxide, acid, and an iron catalyst under General Waste Discharge Requirement Order No. R1-2004-0020.
2. General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2004-0020 were never implemented at the Site.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2004-0044 is rescinded.
