Rescission of Clean-up and Abatement Order 94-17
and Monitoring and Reporting Program Orders 98-115 and 99-16

The Executive Officer of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (hereinafter the Regional Water Board) finds that:

1. On January 24, 1994, the Regional Water Board issued Cleanup and Abatement Order 94-17 requiring Cream's Dismantling and Scrap, Inc. (Discharger) to investigate and cleanup surface waters and groundwater impacted by releases from the site.
2. On October 26, 1998 the Regional Water Board issued Monitoring and Reporting Program (M&R) No. 98-115 requiring quarterly groundwater monitoring at all site wells. M&R No. 98-115 was revised on May 9, 2000 to reduce the number of chemical analyses.
3. On May 11, 1999 the Regional Water Board issued M&R No. 99-16 requiring the Discharger to perform weekly site inspections, maintain appropriate waste management procedures, and to perform biannual stormwater sampling. M&R No.99-16 was revised on May 9, 2000 to reduce the reporting requirements.
4. Investigation of this property has been completed. Based on the available information, no further groundwater monitoring or soil sampling is required to assess the subsurface impacts of the Discharger's activities.
5. Annual stormwater sampling and reporting is still required at this site under the General Industrial Stormwater Permit.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Cleanup and Abatement Order 94-17 and Monitoring and Reporting Program Orders 98-115 and 99-16 be rescinded.
