1. On September 13, 2006, Catherine E. Kuhlman, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2006-0096 for the Alan Wofsy and Finley Avenue Industrial Park facility located at 3840 Finley Avenue in Santa Rosa (Site). The Order contained requirements for monitoring and reporting data collected from the monitoring wells installed at the facility.
2. On September 11, 2007 Regional Water Board staff received communication from staff of the Army Corps of Engineers that groundwater monitoring for the Site was to be completed by the Army Corps of Engineers. Based on the September 11, 2007 information, it is appropriate to rescind Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2006-0096.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2006-0096 is rescinded.
