RECISION OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER NO. 99-74

FOR

JOLENE ROSE and  
RONALD DIXON  
30225 Highway 36  
Bridgeville, California

Humboldt County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (hereinafter Regional Water Board), finds that:

1. Ms. Jolene Rose owns property at 30225 Highway 36, Bridgeville, California, (AP#210-022-03). Mr. Ronald Dixon was a tenant on the property (hereinafter site). Mr. Dixon operated a 3,000 gallon above ground storage tank with no secondary containment. On November 5, 1999 approximately 1,000 gallons of diesel fuel were discharged at the site.
2. The Executive Officer of the Regional Water Board issued Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 99-74 to Jolene Rose and Ronald Dixon on November 15, 1999.
3. Between 1999 and 2001 several remedial actions occurred at the site. These activities included removal and disposal of contaminated soils, and resurfacing of Highway 36.
4. On June 18, 2001, Regional Water Board staff visited the site and determined that all contaminated soils and sources had been removed from the site.
5. Regional Water Board action to rescind Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 99-74 is exempt from provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15061(b)(3).

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 99-74 for Jolene Rose and Ronald Dixon is rescinded.
