


**Resolution No. R1-2004-0068

FRANK CARL REICHMUTH


- WHEREAS, From June 12 through September 22, 1972 and from December 17, 1972 to August 1, 1973, Frank C. Reichmuth was employed by the North Coast Region as a student assistant. Frank is the first student assistant in Region 1 to retire from service.
- WHEREAS, On August 1, 1973, Frank was appointed to the permanent position of Junior Water Quality Control Engineer, assigned to work on a revolutionary new program to regulate nonpoint discharges associated with logging activities.
- WHEREAS, On October 31, 1973, Frank was promoted to Assistant Engineer. Frank's leadership ability was recognized and he became Senior Water Resource Control Engineer in November 1, 1985, Supervising Water Resource Control Engineer on July 1, 1999, and Region One's Assistant Executive Officer, temporarily on October 31, 2001 and permanently on April 25, 2002.
- WHEREAS, Frank, in his early years with the North Coast Regional Board, earned distinction and respect sharing his vast knowledge of proper sampling techniques whenever access to the waters was through cow fields. Step only on the grass clods he would say, thereby keeping boots, state vehicle, and office clean and sanitary.
- WHEREAS, Frank has maintained a consistent and high level of professionalism in developing and implementing water quality policies and programs. Frank has held the respect of water quality professionals in both the regulated and public communities throughout his career and in a variety of situations.






