1. On November 16, 1998, the Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 98-120 (Order) for the Lockheed Martin, Retech Division facility located south of Ukiah (Site). The Order contained requirements for monitoring and reporting data collected from the monitoring wells installed at the Site.
2. On March 18, 2008, North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board staff concurred that no further action was necessary for discharges associated with the area of two former generators and the aboveground diesel storage tank connected to them. North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board staff also concurred with a workplan for destruction of the monitoring wells, which was required prior to Site closure.
3. On October 6, 2008, North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board staff received a report confirming the destruction of the monitoring wells.
4. On October 10, 2008, a "No Further Action" letter was issued to Retech Systems LLC for North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board Case Number 1NMC346. Based on the available information, it is appropriate to rescind Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 98-120.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 98-120 is rescinded.
