This Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) is issued pursuant to California Water Code Section (CWC) 13267(b) and requires monitoring of surface water and submission of technical reports. Reports are required on an annual basis. The objective of monitoring conducted under this monitoring program is to provide the Discharger and the Regional Water Board with information concerning surface water quality and contaminant trends at the site.

Under the authority of CWC section 13267, the Discharger named above is required to comply with the following:

MONITORING

1. The surface water drainage ditch at the south of the property will be sampled annually during March of each year at the historical discharge area and at 30 feet below the historical discharge area. The analyses shall be performed at a certified laboratory for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene, and methyl tert butyl ether (MtBE).

REPORTING

An annual monitoring report, including annual sampling data, shall be submitted to this office by April 24, of each year.
