RESCISSION OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER NO. R1-2001-0100

For G.N. Renn Inc. Spill  
Highway 128, Mile Post. 14.16  
Navarro  
Case No. 1NMC517

Mendocino County

1. On September 11, 2001 a tanker truck owned by G.N. Renn, Inc. (Discharger) overturned on Highway 128 near mile post 14.16, in Navarro, spilling approximately 3,900 gallons of No.2 diesel onto the highway and private property.
2. The Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R1-2001-0100 to the Discharger on September 12, 2001.
3. The Discharger conducted emergency cleanup of the spill, including excavation of impacted soil. Site investigation was completed to define the extent of contamination, groundwater monitoring wells were installed to monitor site conditions over time, and an air sparge system was installed and operated to remediate impacted groundwater. A water supply well impacted by the spill was decommissioned and replaced.
4. On August 16, 2010 the Executive Officer of the Regional Water Board issued a No Further Action letter to the Discharger. All requirements of the Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R1-2001-0100 have been fulfilled through investigative and cleanup activities.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 2001-0100 for the G.N. Renn, Inc. spill is rescinded.
