RESOLUTION ORDER NO. R1-2000-84

SMALL COMMUNITY GRANT PROJECT PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS, The State Water Resources Control Board requires the California Regional Water Quality Control Boards to provide recommendations for Small Community Grant Project priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Garberville Sanitary District desires to be placed on the Small Community Grant Project priority list for upgrading of wastewater collection and treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, the County of Humboldt, Department of Public Health, issued a Declaration of Potential Pollution Problems on August 8 and August 14, 2000 regarding aging wastewater transmission lines suspended over the South Fork Eel River and its tributaries; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, has reviewed the Declaration of Potential Pollution Problems and concurs with the findings and declaration of the County of Humboldt.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, accepts the County of Humboldt Declaration of Potential Pollution Problems and recommends the following addition to the State of California Small Community Grant Project priority list:

Priority Class B – Projects to address existing or potential water pollution problems:

Garberville Sanitary District – reroute/replace two wastewater transmission lines suspended over the South Fork Eel River and its tributaries to a new Humboldt County bridge spanning the South Fork of the Eel River.
